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

Dictionary of Greetings and Weather Terms Weather Songs, annexes to Dictionary


Our first end product, the Dictionary of Greetings and Weather Terms together with Weather Songs annexes are over. The Dictionary includes 13 greetings and 14 weather phrases in all 9 languages of our partners. It is illustrated by pupils' drawings or photos taken by pupils. It also offers the possibility to listen to each term/phrase never mind the language. The annexes include at least one song per partner school, in their mother tongue together with the English translation and audio version. They are also illustrated with pupils' drawings. We are very proud of our common work and really hope it will help children all over Europe to learn a bit of our mother tongues.



2. Climate
